



Some additional information on Colours Clothing & Makeup

During your headshot session it is important that there are no distractions to your face and we can create natural images that “pop out”.

What to avoid

Colours such as white, beige and cream. Large patterns and designs and clothing with logos. Glitter or sparkle make up. Leopard skin prints.

What is good

Black, Navy Blue, Dark Brown, Dark Red, basically any dark colours. Denim is good and can work well with white and black backgrounds.

The camera and lights have a way of cancelling out makeup. In a photo shoot setting, a little more blush, lip colour and eye shadow may be necessary.

Before your headshots shoot, make sure to iron the clothes and hang them on hangers. You want to look good and creases don't look good and cause distraction

The camera never captures makeup and colour in quite as much vibrancy as is visible in real life. Therefore, it is very important that you apply more makeup for photoshoots than you would for going out and looking nice in real life

The perfect makeup for your portrait should give a refined yet natural look.

Clean and refreshed skin looks great in photos. The night before your photo shoot, use a gentle exfoliator or mask as well as toner before you apply moisturizer to prepare your face for photo finished makeup.
